

# Plot Curve

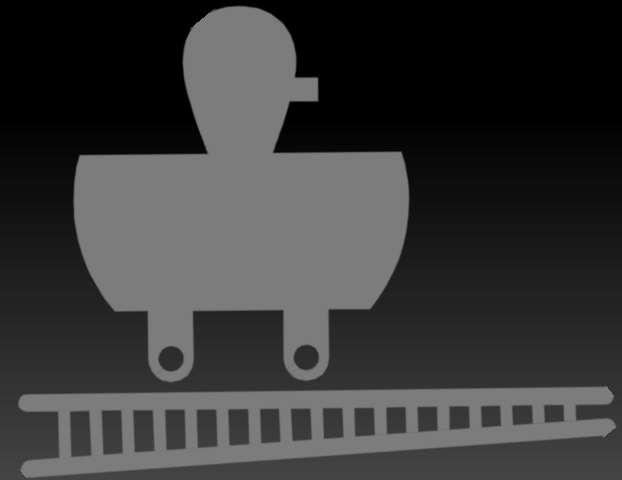


# Plot?

-the arrangement of the incidents in a play, novel, narrative poem, or anything that tells a story.

# Exposition

- Provides background
- Reveals Protagonist
- Reveals Antagonist
- Basic Conflict
- Setting



# Rising Action

- The basic conflicts become more intense
- Protagonist tries to reach his goal
- Antagonist working against protagonist

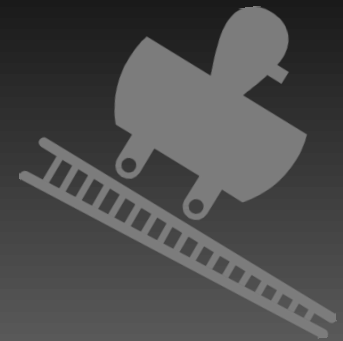
# Climax

- Marks change
- Not always positive
- If things were going well, will change for the worse.
- If things were going badly, they will change for the better.



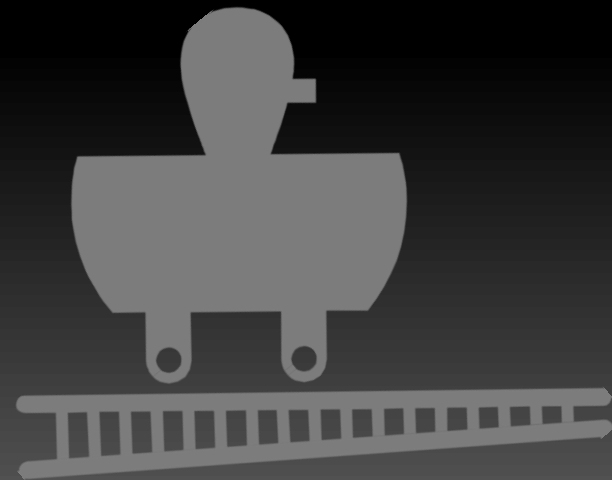
# Falling Action

- The moment of reversal after climax
- Conflict unravels
- Protagonist wins or loses
- May contain suspense



# Resolution

- Serves as the conclusion
- Usually, protagonist is better off
- Some modern works leave the resolution open ended
