Poetry Newsletter Group Project



While studying poetry, you will each pick a poem and write a brief news article about the poem. The articles must cover the 5 w's of writing – who, what, where, when, why, and how. For example, if you were writing about Christina Rossetti's "Goblin Market" you would write about the girls, the goblins, the market, why the girls went to the market, what happened to the girls, and why the goblins chased the girls.

You will then work in a group assigned by Miss Diem to put together a newspaper using Microsoft Publisher. Each member of the group must choose a different poem and each member must submit at least one article and graphic. You will be graded individually and as a team – part of your grade will depend on your team members!

You will have class time to compile and edit your articles, but not to write them!

Requirements:

- Each member of the group must submit one article
- The article must relate back to a poem we studied this semester
- Make sure everything is grammatically correct
- Make sure you edit!
- Answer: who, what, where, when, why, and how
