

UTOPIAN SOCIETY POSTER PROJECT

Pretend that the world is starting over tomorrow – and you want to decide how it will go. As the leader of this new society, you have to give it a name, pick an area, and decide on the rules of the land. You will illustrate a poster to advertise your vision of the new world to other people. In your poster, you should display the name of the world and the rules concerning:

- **Money** – How is money earned? How is it dispersed? Does everyone get an equal amount – or do people work for their individual shares?
- **Environment** – Do you want to live in the rainforest or by the ocean? How will you take care of your environment? Will your new world be a green society?
- **Education** – Will your children go to school? Do they *have* to? What about college?
- **Laws** – Who makes laws? Who enforces them? What happens if someone does not follow a law?
- **Infrastructure** – Where will people live? How will they get from place to place? Will there be a mixture of living environments?
- **Clothing** – Will people be allowed to choose what they wear? Or will there be a uniform?

Design your poster with six different sections – one for each of the categories above. You should have an illustration and a brief description to go along with each of the categories. Make sure you display your new name!
